Barbara will move £10,000 into COIF of which £3500 will be allocated to the play area project as this is grant money we have received.

All the annual accounts have been passed to Christopher Spicer for audit. These will be reviewed at the AGM.

All regular users have been advised of the price increase to hall hire which come into effect 1st April 2023. New prices are displayed in the hall, in the PO and on our website.

Donation from the Saturday Café has been received for the past 2 months - £122.00 in January and £88.00 in February

BOOKING SECRETARY'S REPORT

Nothing to report this month.

REPAIRS AND **M**AINTENANCE

<u>Village Hall</u>

Broadband for the Village Hall has now been arranged and installation will be on or before the 14th March 2023. Service to be provided by BT – Cost of £31.00 per month.

New electric charges will come into effect from 17th March 2023. Unit price increases from 15p to 40p which is a significant jump. This is on a 2-year fixed deal. The alternative to move to flexible unit cost would have been around 60p per unit

Concerns raised that users of the hall need to be more mindful of turning out lights when not needed and also doors to be kept closed so as not to lose heat. One of the issues is that the side fire door is used as an entrance as well, and people pin the outside door open. Paul will arrange a sign to go up on the door to stop this practice. **AP Paul**

Caster on the large table trolly, has a flat spot, which makes it difficult to move. Karl will take a look **AP Karl**

Paul advised that at the moment we are unable to get a grant for Solar Panels at the Village Hall. However we need to keep all information up to date and to hand so that we can apply again in the future especially need to consider a new heating system

Pavilion and Playing Field

Paul advised that the Poo bin at the playing field has gone missing. As this has been broken for some time now, it is hoped that it is being repaired / replaced. To see if this materialises shortly if not to follow up.

The clothing bin was recently full which resulted in people leaving clothes on the floor outside of the bin. Paul did chase up getting this emptied with St Nicolas Hospice, and they did respond with 24 hours so all good again now.

NEW PLAY AREA PROJECT

- We are £26.5K short of our target of £90K
- Paul continues to seek out grants with an application being accepted by Grantscape who are acting for the Mick George Foundation A decision will be made in Mid April 2023
- No funding available from BIFFA (waste disposal people) as hoped for due to a change in their funding eligibility
- Some more ideas raised with Paul at the meeting as to where to possibly apply for funding.

FUND RAISING EVENTS

Both Richard and Barbara think that Tash (who does some of the pub quizzes) would be up for being quizmaster for Village Quiz a couple of times a year. We are too late for March but everyone thought April would be good. Richard / Barbara will advise. **AP Richard / Barbara**
