Repairs and Maintenance

<u>Cleaning</u>

Barbara advised that Alec will no longer be cleaning the hall due to health reasons.

Karen mentioned that the Hall needed a thorough clean – carpets need hoovering, floor to be cleaned and tape removed etc. Several people had commented on the current state of the hall.

Karl will arrange for a thorough one off clean (AP Karl)

Regular cleaner (once or twice a week) is required. Karl to check with Michella to see if she wanted to take this back on (although unlikely). He will also check with cleaning company to see if they could offer a service. Dianne mentioned ladies advertising in Village Magazine – He will also investigate this. (**AP Karl**)

Heating Repairs

Karl advised that the recent work carried out by Austin Heating came to £6250. This covered Removal and replacement of Immersion heater (front of building) Work in Boiler room Full overhaul of Main Heating system Ladies' toilet issues fixed Work on control box

One item that needs confirming is carrying out a Pressure Test on this system to establish oil usage and to ensure there was no internal leak – Karl with chase this up **Disable toilet** – Door / Lighting still needs fixing – Karl will chase up with Peter King (**AP Karl**)

Lighting Karen advised that only 2 of the uplighters in the main hall were working – Karl will arrange for replacement bulbs to be fitted (AP Karl)

Karl has spoken to some firms and hopes to have more information for discussion t next meeting (**ongoing action**)

New Trees on Playing Field to mark Queens Platinum Jubilee

General discussion took place as to what type of trees could be planted and where. As there are already a lot of large trees around the playing field, consideration will be given to perhaps installing some ornamental or fruit trees around the Pavilion area. No consensus reached at this time - for further discussion. (ongoing action)

New seating at Playing Field

Karl is keen to get some new seating installed at the playing field – He proposed that we should consider these be in durable brown plastic wood effect to make them more practical and remove the need for treatment etc. – agreed by all. Need to agree on shape and size. Karl will get full costings etc. (**ongoing action**)

<u>Village Quiz</u> Saturday 16th October 2021 Karl advised that he has spoken to John Speare who is happy to take on the role of quizmaster for the Quiz Night.
